From the Baxter Theatre Centre at University of Cape Town in South Africa comes THE FALL. THE FALL was devised collaboratively by a cast of seven actors who recount their experiences as student leaders of the #RhodesMustFall protest movement, which called for the takedown of a colonialist monument on their University of Cape Town campus. Marshalling their power of protest songs and dance, THE FALL exposes the impact of inflammatory icons, high tuition and crushing student debt. A hit at this year's Edinburgh Festival Fringe and London's Royal Court Theatre, THE FALL is the perfect production to inspire and challenge students to participate in civic discourse and stand up for their beliefs in constructive ways.
